RAE-K 5036

The RAE-K and RAE-H series is a programme of self-actuating proportional controllers with a small P-band.

The sensor range includes:

- RAE-K 5034 with built-in sensor
- RAE-K 5036 with remote sensor
- RAE-K 5134 with built-in sensor and positive shut-off
- RAE-H 5035 with built-in sensor

The RAE-K sensors can be used on valve bodies from the following producers: Kermi, Henrad, Purmo, DEF, Dianorm, Diatherm, Biasi, Radson, Ferroli, Stelrad, Kaimann, Arbonia, Superia and Veba and also on the steel tube radiator from Buderus.

The RAE-H 5035 sensor are designed for valve bodies from the producer Herz.

All sensors are equipped with facilities for frost protection and for limiting and locking the temperature set-point.

The RAE-K 5036 RA 2922 is equipped with 2 m of ultra-thin capillary tube, which is coiled up within the remote sensor housing. After sensor mounting capillary tube is pulled out to the required length.

The RAE-K and RAE-H series comes in the colour white RAL 9010.

¹⁾ Temperatures stated for $X_p = 2K$, i.e. the valve is closed at 2 °C higher room temperature.

²⁾ The remote sensor is delivered with all of the capillary tube coiled up within the sensor. When mounting the sensor, only the capillary tube required is uncoiled.

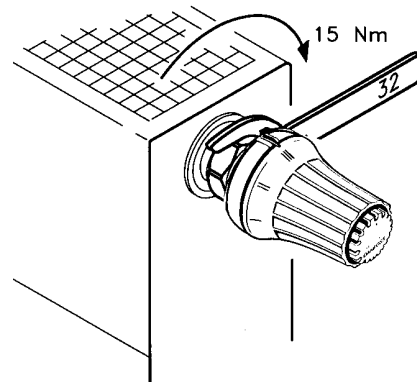
³⁾ Protection ring to prevent unintended removal of the sensor. No tools are required for mounting the protection ring.

Mounting

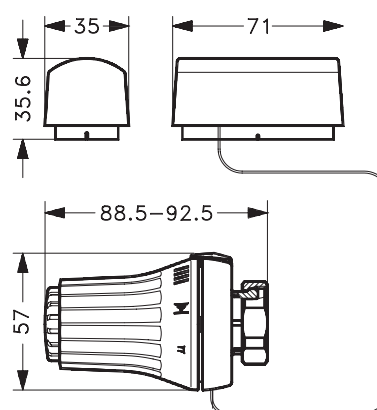
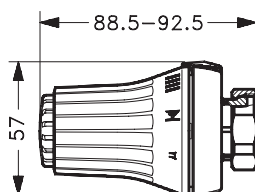
An open-end spanner is used for mounting the sensor onto the valve body.

Instructions for installation are included with the product.

The sensor should always be placed where the room air can circulate freely around it.
