

## Customer information according to European Chemicals Regulation – Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals

REACH is a European Union regulation that was enacted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals and, at the same time, to increase the competitiveness of the chemical industry in the EU. To this end, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) maintains a list of chemical substances of very high concern (SVHC) registered in the EU. This candidate list includes, among other things, the names of the substances as well as identification codes such as EC and CAS numbers.

Article 33(1) of the EU REACH Regulation stipulates that any supplier of an article containing a substance registered by the candidate list in a concentration greater than 0.1% by weight shall provide the recipient of the article with the information available to him that is sufficient for the safe use of the article, but at least the name of the substance concerned.

Based on the current legal requirements, we inform you about substances from the ECHA candidate list that are used in our products. We use these substances in our products, e.g. in lithium metal cells and brass flow sensors.

For the purposes of Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, the following products sold by us are classified as articles:

- SensoStar      Heat meter
- SensoStar C    Arithmetic Unit
- Flowstar      Volume measuring part
- HCAe2        Heat cost allocator
- Gateway      Gateway

According to information from our suppliers, the following substances on the ECHA candidate list (as of June 10, 2022) are contained in our products:
