

## Compliance to REACH legislation 1907/2006/EU

The declared aim of REACH is to improve the level of knowledge about the dangers and risks that chemicals may pose, to achieve a higher protection level for man and environment. REACH affects all chemicals, as well those which are in use for a long time. Further, REACH acts to shift the responsibility for the risk assessment of chemicals in large part from the authorities to the producers.

According to REACH legislation, DIVELLO is classified as a downstream user and therefore not obliged to register its products.

DIVELLO relies on the close cooperation and activities with our market leading production partners for securing our future supply with safe chemicals and mixtures and confirming our compliance with REACH requirements.

DIVELLO, in cooperation with our production partners, actively follow the SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) list as published by ECHA (European Chemical Agency) and adapt our usage of chemical substances accordingly when needed. The evaluation of the current REACH legislation states that DIVELLO fulfill the obligation of the current REACH regulation.

It is, however, not always avoidable to make use of substances which meet the criteria of article 57 in the REACH regulation.

According to REACH Art.33 we inform you that in some DIVELLO products with brass components, lead is being applied as an alloying constituent in concentrations > 0.1 % of the brass component. The brass components are mainly used as connecting parts that are not in contact with drinking water.

The safe use of the DIVELLO products is of course guaranteed, and we have no indication that the aforementioned substance would impair the safe use of the products for their intended purpose.
